## January 2025 News

To ring in the new year, we have an exciting announcement. Everyone that submits attendance reports is getting a bigger allowance for curriculum reinforcements (prizes). And we are creating a tiered program where facilities with larger numbers of attendances will receive a larger allowance. This will give residents in facilities with more attendances more equitable allowances for their goodies.

Here are the tiers: Tier 1 1 to 50 attenda

1 to 50 attendances \$200 per quarter

North Carolina

Tier 2 51 to 75 attendances \$250 per quarter

Tier 376+ attendances\$300 per quarter

How do we figure 'attendances?' We use your attendance forms and count the number of attendances from the entire month. It is **not** the number of participants, but it is the total times all of your participating residents attend sessions.

Here are some example:

- *Peaceful Pines* had 6 sessions and 50 attendances, so would be in Tier 1/\$200 per quarter.
- Shady Acres had 7 sessions and 70 attendances. They would fall into Tier 2/\$250 per quarter.
- Cozy Cove had 9 sessions and 101 attendances and would be in Tier 3/\$300 per quarter.

We know that all facilities have off months, so we will average the two months prior to your order to make it as fair as possible. If your facility was under lockdown for illness, we will not penalize you for that and will look at the history of your program to determine your tier ranking.

You will need to submit attendance forms **every** month so we can make an accurate accounting of your curriculum reinforcement (prize) needs. We are trying to make a fairer distribution of assets for all <u>residents. A facility that hosts</u> 9 sessions and 222 attendances each month, gets more goodies.

Because we are increasing your curriculum reinforcement (prize) budget, there will no longer be a drawing for attendance winners for submitting your attendance forms on time. If you do not submit attendance forms, your facility will stay in the original \$150/quarter allowance.
